

Berlin Lake Trail Opens October 22

Join the Portage Park District, the Berlin Lake Association and other partners for the opening of the Berlin Lake Trail on Saturday, October 22 at 10:00 a.m. A ribbon cutting and dedication ceremony will be followed by a guided nature walk on the trail. The event will be held at the SR 224 parking lot trailhead, 1.5 miles east of Deerfield Circle.

This beautiful 2.2 mile stone-surfaced railtrail crosses Berlin Lake, with views of the water and wildlife, including bald eagles, herons and ospreys. Parking and access is also available at the south end, off of Kirkbride Rd., just north of its intersection with SR 14. The trail will be open dawn to dusk all year long for hiking, biking and fishing access, however no jumping or fishing is permitted off of the bridge.
